



# DAYCARE TIMETABLE 2024-25 (AGES 17 MONTHS - 2 YEARS)

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Daycare pick up times are either; **Option 1 Academic: 12:30, Option 2 Activities: 14:00** or **Option 3 Aftercare: 15:30** on Mondays-Thursdays and at **12:30 on first & last Fridays.**

**Late pick up** Parents have a 15-minute grace period, after which they will be charged \$20/hour if students are picked up later than their scheduled time.

8:30-9:30 Period 2	<b>Fine Motor Skills Development for Language and Math</b> <i>Pre-Writing Activities; dot to dot, straight down/across, horizontal, diagonal, &amp; curved lines, tracing letters or numbers, drawing letters in sand, writing alphabets and numbers</i>				
9:30-10:00 Period 3	<b>Outdoor Science Exploration &amp; Playground:</b> <i>nature walks, sand and water table, and sensory play materials.</i>				
10-10:30 BREAK	<b>BREAK IN CLASS</b> Eat snacks, drink water and washroom use.				
10:30-11:30 Period 4	<b>Creative Arts</b> <i>Bristol color papers, playdough, scissors, glue, paint etc or Fine Motor Play: painting, coloring, playdough, stacking toys.</i> <i>* Students must have their Art Aprons left in class Mon-Fri. They will be sent home at the end of each week for a wash.</i>				
11:30-12:30 LUNCH	<b>RECESS ON PRESCHOOL PLAYGROUND AND LUNCH IN CLASS!</b> <i>Option 1 students get ready to go home, while others get ready for activities!</i>				
12:30-13:00	<b>Students change for activities</b> <i>* Students must have each day's respective activity uniform packed in their bags in order to participate in activities.</i>				
13:00-14:00	<b>Karate</b>	<b>Dance</b>	<b>Soccer</b>	<b>Swim</b>	<b>Music</b>
14:00-14:15	<i>Option 2 students get ready to go home, while aftercare students return to class.</i>				
14:15-15:30	Complete unfinished classwork, quiet play time; read, color, puzzles, or take a nap.				



## WHAT SHOULD PARENTS SEND DAILY?

<b>Classes</b>	<b>Parents to send in child's bag daily/as needed.</b>
<b>Daycare/Toddler</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) 1 packet of diapers/pull ups to keep in the child's class cubby <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i></li><li>2) Sippy cup with water or milk (No glass bottles please)</li><li>3) 1 extra set of clothes and underwear</li><li>4) FLA activities clothes for the day *</li><li>5) 1 box of tissue to keep in the class <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i></li><li>6) Healthy lunch and snack or FLA lunch and snack</li><li>7) Mosquito repellent <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i></li><li>8) Sterimar or any nasal spray with anti-histamine syrup (If allergies exist) during allergy seasons</li><li>9) Hand sanitizer bottle <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i></li><li>10) Wet wipes</li><li>11) Hat/Cap</li><li>12) Waterproof sunblock lotion for swim days</li><li>13) Asthma sufferers should have their emergency kit labelled and kept in the infirmary</li><li>14) 1 Liter bottle of water</li><li>15) Student journal signed (daily)</li><li>16) 2 Small towels for hand/face to be sent home weekly for washing</li></ol>
