

Parents Invited

- Students are expected to arrive by 7:00 a.m.
- All students from Grades 1-9 arriving late, after 7:30 a.m. will not be allowed into the classroom and must wait in the front office for the next period class.
- On heavy rainfall days, we ask that students arrive at 8:00 am
- Early dismissal requests must be made in writing with the date, student's full name, grade and reason of dismissal, and directed to the Staff Admin's attention.
- Parents, maids, and drivers are not allowed in classrooms for drop-off, pick-up, or check-out. All students must be dropped off and picked up at the designated station or the front office.
- If a **new person will be picking up** a student, it is the Parent/guardian's responsibility to notify the office.
- Parents must send a message in writing to the school to notify the office if a student will be absent.
- An absence of three days or more requires a note from the doctor.
- Ill students may return only once fully cured and with a doctor's note.
- For student leave exceeding three days, parents must submit a written request to the administration at least one week in advance, stating the reason and duration. Approval depends on academic standing and request details.
- In all cases, it is the student's or parent's responsibility to catch up on missed work upon their return.

In registering your child, you are responsible for paying 1 Entire Academic Year of school. FLA has facilitated your payment by providing you with the option of paying by trimester in 3 instalments or monthly in 10 payment instalments. If you decide to change your Payment option from Yearly or by Trimester after selecting and signing a payment option, at any point during the academic year, please note that penalty fees may be applicable. If you wish to withdraw your child from FLA, a written notice is required 1 trimester prior to the withdrawal date. The next payment(s) (Monthly or by Trimester) will still be due, even if the child will not be attending school. Registration is for 1 Academic Year. All fees paid are Non-Refundable.

First Payments inclusive of registration, placement tests, books, learning materials, infirmary, supplies, textbook *rentals*, photocopies, student and class photos, yearbooks, events and field trips must be paid in full to Future Leaders Academy, prior to the first day of class.

Second payment due will be for the **Tuition Fees and Meals.**

If payments are not received within the first 5 academic days, penalty fees of **10**% will apply the first week, and increase over the course of the month, FLA also holds the right to withhold your child's report card.

If payments are not received within 30 days, FLA has the right to automatically withdraw your child from his/her class. This may impact your child's ability to sit examinations. We have a strict "no pay, no class" policy.

We kindly urge you to settle any outstanding payments at the earliest to ensure your child's full participation in the lessons and exams. Please note that teachers will not be making special arrangements for missed exams due to late payments, which may directly impact students' grades. It is up to parents to respect their payment commitment.

All your payments must be made directly to the office in cash (only if under \$50), if over, you may pay by debit or deposit directly into FLA's bank account. Post-dated cheques and cash exceeding \$50 will not be accepted in the office.
