WHAT SHOULD PARENTS SEND IN CHILD'S BAG?

- 1) 1 extra set of clothes and underwear
- 2) FLA activities clothes for the day
- 3) 1 box of tissue to keep in the class

- 11) Asthma sufferers should have their emergency kit labelled and kept in the infirmary
- 12) 1.5 Liter bottle of water
- 13) Student journal signed (daily)
- 14) 2 Small towels for hand/face to be sent home weekly for washing
