



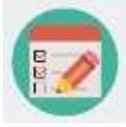

WHAT SHOULD PARENTS SEND IN CHILD'S BAG?

Classes	Parents to send in child's bag daily/as needed.
Toddler	1) 1 packet of diapers/pull ups to keep in the child's class cubby <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i> 2) Sippy cup with water or milk (No glass bottles please) 3) 1 extra set of clothes and underwear 4) FLA activities clothes for the day 5) 1 box of tissue to keep in the class <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i> 6) Healthy lunch and snack or FLA lunch and snack 7) Mosquito repellent <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i> 8) Sterimar or any nasal spray with antihistamine syrup (If allergies exist- to be given to infirmary) during allergy seasons 9) Hand sanitizer bottle <i>When the stock is nearly finished, the teacher will notify you.</i> 10) Wet wipes 11) Hat/Cap 12) Waterproof sunblock lotion for swim days 13) Asthma sufferers should have their emergency kit labelled and kept in the infirmary 14) 1 Liter bottle of water 15) Student journal signed (daily) 16) 2 Small towels for hand/face to be sent home weekly for washing
